• \$75 million over the next three years to the Rural Dividend Program, to help struggling communities reinvigorate and diversify their local economies.

Forest Enhancement Society of BC https://news.gov.bc.ca/releases/2016FLNR0018-000284

- Funding of \$95M for Wildfire Management Initiatives including:
 - o \$85M to establish a new organization Forest Enhancement Society of BC to:
 - Salvage harvesting of dead timber
 - Wildlife habitat restoration in MPB impacted areas
 - Enhancement of low-productivity/uneconomic high elevation hemlock and balsam stands
 - Fire scaping fuel management treatments
 - Advance wildfire prevention and mitigation objectives through forest fuel management, reforestation and habitat restoration.
 - \$10M for the Strategic Wildfire Prevention Initiative for Community Wildfire Protection Plans, Fire Smart Planning Activities and Fuel Management Projects.
 - o Initial Society Board is being established.

Land based investment fund

- Increase by \$12M to \$107.15M
- Focus of activities are on areas impacted by MPB and wildfires that are the responsibility of Government to reforest.
